A Clean Heart
O God*

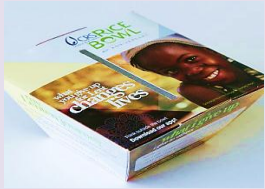
At our 9am Mass this weekend, we celebrated the first of three **Scrutinies** with the children and adults who will be celebrating the Easter Sacraments in just a few weeks. While we do not often use the word *scrutiny*, it describes an activity we do on a pretty regular basis. It's what we do when we get up in the morning and look in the mirror. We check out our skin, eyes, teeth and hair to make sure we will be able to look our best. We older folks notice thinning hair and the latest wrinkles and wonder where that blemish came from overnight. We also are likely to *scrutinize* at least some of the people we see during the day. That person looks a little odd....what did they have in mind dressing that way.....is that a stud on that young girl's tongue? I hear that some men are especially good at scrutinizing (i.e. checking out) some of the more shapely women they encounter along the way.

However, when the word *scrutiny* is used in the context of the rite we celebrate with the unbaptized on the third, fourth, and fifth Sundays of Lent, it refers to the Lord who looks deep into us with his loving gaze. God can read our hearts and see whatever may be hidden there. Do we really love him with our whole mind, heart, and soul? Have we been acting as intentional disciples of Jesus Christ? Are we spreading the joy of the gospel to others? When we exercise the courage to peer inside ourselves, we know that we could really use *a clean heart*. God will gladly give us one if we are willing to have our sins exposed and purged by his merciful love. In this sense, the *Scrutinies* are a form of *exorcism*. This is a special kind of grace that makes it possible for us to acknowledge that we are unlikely to turn away from our sins without God's divine intervention.

In his letter to the Romans, St. Paul expressed his anxiety regarding the tension that lies deep within the heart of believers because of sin. He says, "*For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do—this I keep on doing. Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it.*" Then he says, "*Who will save me from my own wretchedness? Thanks be to God, through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.*" We still have a few weeks of Lent to open ourselves more fully to this grace which the Lord freely gives to those who seek him with contrite and humble hearts.
