All volunteers must attend Mass on a weekly basis, providing an example of their faith to our younger members, as we are all called to be "INTENTIONAL Disciples of Christ".

Catechists: Willing to commit to teaching weekly RE sessions. Training is provided as needed.

Aides: Willing to commit to assisting our teachers with weekly sessions.

Program Helper: These are parents who would be helping during registration, passing out forms and helping answer any questions that new registrants have. This would basically be done between the masses at the beginning and the end of every new Sunday school year. Helping during the beginning of the year, directing people to the appropriate rooms for their children.

Safety Parent: The Archdiocesan Safe Environment Program requires that two adults be in the classroom at all times. "Safety Parents" is the term we are using for those who would be willing, on occasion, to sit in a classroom when a catechist or their aid is not able to be present due to illness. We always make every attempt to finding a substitute, but sometimes last minute emergencies prevent this. You would not be asked to teach; you would only be asked to sit in the room to be another adult presence in the room.

Donut Helpers: This would be someone assisting in passing out donut holes to the students before classes start. This would give the current parent some assistance on days that he or she will not be able to help out.

Vacation Bible School Helpers: This would be someone assisting in registering children, or helping out as a crew leader or in any other way that would be of assistance.

Substitutes: We are always in need of substitute teachers and aides; this would prevent **burn out** for those wonderful substitutes that we already have. It would be nice to have a full roster of available substitutes so that in case of an emergency we have enough substitutes to call on.

All of these positions would require Safe Environment training as mandated by the Archdiocese for the protection of our children.
